





WINTER TIME-OF-USE & TIERED **SCHEDULES IN EFFECT NOVEMBER 1 TO APRIL 30, 2025**

LUI HAS APPLIED TO DECREASE DISTRIBUTION RATES

Lakefront Utilities Inc. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to change its electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2025. If the application is approved, a typical residential customer would see a decrease of approximately \$1.89 per month. KING STREET WEST RECONSTRUCTION

Town of Cobourg and Lakefront Utility Services hosted a Public Information Meeting on September 17th regarding the King Street West Reconstruction project scheduled for 2025.

Reconstruction work will include:

- Replacement of the watermain, sanitary sewer and storm sewer, as well as the concrete sidewalk, road curbs and asphalt pavement.
- Replacement of water and sanitary sewer services to the property line and connection to existing service pipes.
- Minor repairs to the King Street West / Cobourg Creek bridge and the construction of a new realigned entrance to Wastewater Pollution Control Plant #1.
- Construction of a 2.5m wide concrete multiuse path on the south side of King Street West, replacing the existing 1.2m wide concrete sidewalk. This will provide an off-road travel area for cyclists and pedestrians separated from vehicular traffic.

DISCLOSURE: ASSURANCE OF VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE

In October 2023, Lakefront Utilities Inc. discovered a billing error that caused some charges to be higher than those approved by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB).

This error, affecting 4,077 invoices from January 2019 to October 2023, resulted in overcharges totaling \$3,831.22 (about 27 cents per residential customer) due to the incorrect application of prorated fixed monthly charges for the first and last bill of partial months (move-in and move-out).

We apologize for this error and assure you we corrected the issue in November 2023 and provided an Assurance of Voluntary Compliance to the OEB, which was accepted on July 18, 2024.
