







Time-of-Use (TOU) Hours¹

D'ARCY STREET WATER TOWER CONNECTING ZONES 1 & 2

The Town of Cobourg and Lakefront Utility Services Inc. have issued a tender for a linear construction project to connect water infrastructure from Zone 1 to the new Elevated Tank and Booster Pumping Station on D'Arcy Street and into Zone 2.

The contract will be awarded in January 2025, with construction beginning in February. Temporary disruptions are expected along D'Arcy Street from Kerr Street to the roundabout, and from Barracks Drive to Brook Creek while construction is underway.


